Arrowwood viburnum (<i>Viburnum dentatum</i>)	6'-12'
Burkwood viburnum (<i>Viburnum x burkwoodii</i>)	6'-8'
Dwarf Alberta spruce (<i>Picea glauca 'Conica'</i>)	6'-12'
Dwarf Flowering Almond (<i>Prunus glandulosa</i>)	6'-7'
Dwarf Korean lilac (<i>Syringa meyeri palibin</i>)	5'
Flowering Quince (<i>Chaenomeles speciosa</i>)	6'-10'
Forsythia "northern gold"	6'-8'
French and Canadian hybrid lilacs	8'-10'
Hydrangea (<i>macrophylla</i>)	4'-6'
Mary Potter crabapple (<i>Malus x 'Mary Potter'</i>)*	10'-12'
Mockorange (<i>Philadelphus</i> Var.)	4'-12'
Mugo pine (<i>Pinus mugo</i>)	8'-10'
Northern bayberry (<i>Myrica pensylvanica</i>)	5'-9'
Purple leaf sand cherry (<i>Prunus x cistena</i>)	6'-8'
Red Twigged Dogwood (<i>Cornus alba</i>)	8'-10'
Red-osier dogwood (<i>Cornus sericea</i>)	8'-10'
Sargent crabapple (<i>Malus sargentii</i>)*	6'-10'
Weigela ('red prince')	6'

No trees or shrubs should be planted within 10 feet of pad-mount transformers, towers, poles or wood structures.
