CORPORATE COMMITMENT

Energy needs for members voluntarily participating in the Wabash Valley Power Association Co-op Solar program will be supplied from the environmentally-preferred source of solar power. Currently that source has a higher cost than most other sources of power. The Solar Rider currently reflects an increased cost of forty-four cents (\$.44) per share per month over the Corporation's standard rates.

It is our hope that as members choose alternative solar power, additional investments will be made in environmentally-friendly generation.

AVAILABILITY

Available to Corporation members in all territory served by the Corporation, subject to the Corporation's Service Rules and Regulations.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to any member of the Corporation for single-phase or multi-phase service located on or adjacent to the lines of the Corporation and suitable and adequate for receiving the service requested.

Members may choose the number of shares in which they would like to participate up to the average monthly usage of the account. Accounts will be limited to 83 shares. Each share is currently estimated to provide on average 43 kWh per month.

MONTHLY RATE

Solar Power Charge: \$0.44 per share per month in addition to the Corporation's standard rates and charges.

RATE ADJUSTMENT

The above rates are subject to a Purchased Power Cost Adjustment Tracking Factor, in accordance with the Corporation's policy and practices.

CHANGE IN FUEL COST CHARGE

This Solar Power rate listed is not subject to a changing fuel cost charge component.

NON-RECURRING CHARGES

The above rate is subject to Non-Recurring Charges. These charges are stated in the Appendix, "Provisions Applicable to All Rates, Non-Recurring Charges," pages 1 and 2, and are applicable hereto. Appendix, "Provisions Applicable to All Rates, Non-Recurring Charges," is issued and is effective on the date shown on the Appendix.
